# LANCASTER COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANTS (CDBG)

# SUMMARY

The Lancaster County Redevelopment Authority can fund a variety of stormwater management improvements under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Improvements Program.

- Administered by Lancaster County Redevelopment Authority
- Annual program funding: varies depending on federal HUD allocations
- Program funding (2019): \$1,325,000
- Funding Source: Federal Budget US Department of Housing & Urban Development

## ELIGIBILITY

#### Who is Eligible?

Low-to-moderate income areas in Lancaster County (excluding the City of Lancaster). See CWQE Support Hub for map of eligible municipalities in Lancaster County.

#### **Eligible Costs**

Eligible activities include stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs) as part of neighborhood improvement projects; funds stormwater improvements, water and sewer lines, curb & sidewalk replacement. Covers 95 percent of construction costs up to \$200,000.

Match: 20% match of total project cost and 5% match for construction costs required. Engineering and design are generally contributed as match.

### **FEATURES**

All projects must benefit residents in an area that is at least 46.74% low- and moderateincome. (City of Lancaster administers own CBGB).

Maximum grant awards of \$200,000 per project; can apply for 2 projects per funding cycle.

The service area of a project must be primarily residential.

### HELPFUL TIPS

Projects should be shovel-ready; must be fully implemented within one year of contracting and 50% completed within six months.

Program allows for phased projects over 4-5 years.

Must hold a public hearing prior to submitting the final funding request.
