SUMMARY

DCNR's C2P2 provides reimbursable grants for land acquisition projects involving community recreation and critical habitat/open space.

- Administered by PA DCNR Bureau of Recreation and Conservation
- Annual Funding: \$30 \$50 million/year
- Funding Sources: State Keystone Recreation, Park & Conservation Fund, Environmental Stewardship Fund, PA Heritage Areas Program; Federal – Land & Water Conservation Fund

ELIGIBILITY

Who is Eligible?

Counties, municipalities, state agencies (Community Recreation), approved pre-qualified land trusts (Critical Habitat/Open Space)

Eligible Costs

Appraisal, technical reviews, surveys, legal work associated with parcel, title commitment and insurance, settlement costs, Phase One ESA's, DCNR funding signage, fee acquisitions and conservation easements.

1:1 cash or non-cash match required. Only acceptable non-cash match is donated land value.

FEATURES

Awarded projects have contract period of four years, but most close within 1-2 years.

Project budget must include the land easement purchase cost and other eligible costs.

An appraisal must be submitted with the application and must be less than one year old.

Public access is required for community recreation projects; it is not required but is highly recommended for critical habitat/open space projects.

HELPFUL TIPS

For conservation easements, DCNR will only fund the highest protection area.

Focus on how project protects lands that enhance landscape connectivity and recreational access to existing protected lands.
