SUMMARY

DCNR's C2P2 provides reimbursable grants for projects that advance collaborative multi-municipal or large-landscape recreation, conservation, and heritage projects.

- Administered by PA DCNR Bureau of Recreation and Conservation
- Annual Funding: \$30 \$50 million/year
- Funding Sources: State Keystone Recreation, Park & Conservation Fund, Environmental Stewardship Fund, Heritage Area Funding

ELIGIBILITY

Who is Eligible?

Municipalities, statewide and regional non-profit organizations, regional municipal entities, PA Heritage Areas

Eligible Costs

Educational conferences, workshops, publication development, public forums, economic assessments, marketing plans, preservation plans, special feasibility studies, construction, public outreach, program facilitation, establishment of mini-grant programs

Minimum match is 20%, but 1:1 match is encouraged. For Mini-Grant Projects, 1:1 match is required.

Intended for projects that have an impact at the county level or larger.

Funds projects that help build local, county, regional, and statewide capacity to better develop and manage resources through the creation and implementation of public planning processes.

Includes four types of projects: Convening/Education/Training, Special Purpose Planning, Implementation, and Mini-Grants.
