

C2P2 DCNR GRANT ROUND SUPPLEMENTAL ROUND – FALL 2022



SUMMARY

DCNR is offering a supplemental grant program in fall 2022 to support Community Conservation Partnerships Program (C2P2) projects.

- Administered by PA DCNR Bureau of Recreation and Conservation
- Annual Funding: \$38 million/year (2022/23)
- Funding Sources: State Budget; \$25 million coming from federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021

FEATURES

Supplemental C2PS funding made available by federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

Ideal time for small community grants – areas with fewer than 5,000 people. Only 20% match required for small community grants.

Roughly \$8.8 million available for the fall 2022 round of funding to support Community & Forestry proposals. See FAQs for this part of the grant round.

ELIGIBILITY

Who is Eligible?

Counties, municipalities, councils of governments, conservation districts, non-profit organizations

Eligible Costs

Recreation/conservation planning, park rehab/development, small community development, land acquisition and conservation, trails, rivers conservation, riparian buffers, urban tree planting, lawn conversion, partnership projects

Match: most projects require 1:1 match; lower 20% match for projects in smaller communities (< 5,000 populations), partnership/heritage projects, riparian buffers, TreeVitalize, tree planting and lawn conversion.

Davis-Bacon (prevailing wage) requirements do not apply to these grant projects, unless the project has funding from federal sources besides the State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF).

Announcement targeted for January 2023.
