

CREP Mini-Grant Program



SUMMARY

The Pennsylvania Association of Conservation Districts offers mini-grants to implement educational and outreach activities that support and extend the work of the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP).

- Program administered by PACD
- Program Funding: \$100,000
- Source of Funding: PA DEP Growing Greener Watershed Protection Grant, USDA NRCS

FEATURES

Projects should focus on CREP enrollment, re-enrollment, and/or CREP maintenance.

Projects should focus on landowners primarily, but also contractors, municipal officials, and watershed organizations that would benefit from outreach activities.

Maximum award amount is \$3,000.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible Costs

Projects can include educational field days and workshops, one-on-one visits with property owners, or riparian buffer installation.

Mileage and costs to produce outreach materials will be eligible for reimbursement.

Ineligible costs include t-shirts, magnets, pens, and other novelty items.

HELPFUL TIPS

All project materials (brochures, signs, presentations, etc.) must be reviewed by PACD's Program Manager prior to use.

Evaluations are required for mini-grant workshops, field days, and walk-about.
